Civic school children turn the tables on mediocrity

Nagpur: Some students dread mathematics while some just love the numbers. It may be surprising for many but the students of NMC-run Durga Nagar Hindi Primary School belong to the second lot.

Municipal commissioner Shyam Wardhane, who made a surprise visit to this school on Tuesday morning, was himself surprised to find students here knowing tables up to 65.

Eight-year-old Prakash Kathar, a Class IV student recited multiplication tables up to 65. "He has shown immense interest in learning and solving calculations," explained mathematics teacher Bharati Gajam. Like him, almost every student of this school, which has a strength of 116 from Class I to V, can leave anyone astonished with their effortless recitation of tables of any number between 1 and 65.

Two months ago, these students were not even able to even recite tables of 2.

This phenomenal change is the result of Mission Parivartan launched by Wardhane in NMC-run schools in this academic year. Wardhane introduced this mass recitation of multiplication tables at school assembly in Pune schools — where he served as zilla parishad CEO and in Sangli (where he served as district collector). Later, mayor Anil Sole asked civic administration to im-

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plement it in every civic school in the city.

The students also demonstrated their sharp memory, particularly while solving lengthy mathematical calculations.

Education committee

chairman and senior BJP corporator Chetna Tank and Hanuman Nagar zone committee chairman Raju Nagulwar were mesmerized by their talent. Gajam said the launch of Mission Parivartan motivated the teachers to impart knowledge to students. "Multiplication is one of the most important numerical skills that is used all through life," said Wardhane.

"We want to make learning to multiply fun. Normally it is something you learn through drill. We want it to be something students will want to learn. The plan is to train a few students first and then ask them to show their talent before children during morning prayers. The project does not require any funds or infrastructure, it just needs motivation," he said.

Tank and Nagulwar, who accompanied the civic chief, asked the students to solve problems like multiplication and division. Students said now mathematics had become their favourite subject. Pranjali Dubey, a Standard III student, said for her maths was now fun.
